Matthew 16:20-26

1 Corinthians 1:18-30

Matthew 16:20-26 (New Revised Standard Version)

Then he sternly ordered the disciples not to tell anyone that he was the Messiah. From that time on, Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and undergo great suffering at the hands of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised. And Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him, saying, “God forbid it, Lord! This must never happen to you.” But he turned and said to Peter, “Get behind me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to me; for you are setting your mind not on divine things but on human things.” Then Jesus told his disciples, “If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. For those who want to save their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will find it. For what will it profit them if they gain the whole world but forfeit their life? Or what will they give in return for their life?”

1 Corinthians 1:18-30 (New Revised Standard Version)

For the message about the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. For it is written, “I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and the discernment of the discerning I will thwart.” Where is the one who is wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? For since, in the wisdom of God, the world did not know God through wisdom, God decided, through the foolishness of our proclamation, to save those who believe. For Jews demand signs and Greeks desire wisdom, but we proclaim Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles, but to those who are the called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. For God’s foolishness is wiser than human wisdom, and God’s weakness is stronger than human strength. Consider your own call, brothers and sisters: not many of you were wise by human standards, not many were powerful, not many were of noble birth. But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong; God chose what is low and despised in the world, things that are not, to reduce to nothing things that are, so that no one might boast in the presence of God. He is the source of your life in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification and redemption.

Leader: This is the word of the Lord.

People: **Thanks be to God.**

Mateo 16:20-26 (Nueva Versión Internacional)

²⁰ Luego les ordenó a sus discípulos que no dijeran a nadie que él era el Cristo.

1 Corintios 1:18-30 (Nueva Versión Internacional)

¹⁸ Me explico: El mensaje de la cruz es una locura para los que se pierden; en cambio, para los que se salvan, es decir, para nosotros, este mensaje es el poder de Dios.
¹⁹ Pues está escrito: «Destruiré la sabiduría de los sabios; frustraré la inteligencia de los inteligentes». ²⁰ ¿Dónde está el sabio? ¿Dónde el erudito? ¿Dónde el filósofo de esta época? ¿No ha convertido Dios en locura la sabiduría de este mundo?
²¹ Ya que Dios, en su sabio designio, dispuso que el mundo no lo conociera mediante la sabiduría humana, tuvo a bien salvar, mediante la locura de la predicación, a los que creen.
²² Los judíos piden señales milagrosas y los gentiles buscan sabiduría,

²⁷ Pero Dios escogió lo insensato del mundo para avergonzar a los sabios, y escogió lo débil del mundo para avergonzar a los poderosos.
²⁸ También escogió Dios lo más bajo y despreciado, y lo que no es nada, para anular lo que es,
²⁹ a fin de que en su presencia nadie pueda jactarse.
³⁰ Pero gracias a él ustedes están unidos a Cristo Jesús, a quien Dios ha hecho nuestra sabiduría —es decir, nuestra justificación, santificación y redención—

This year, instead of bringing items to church to be donated, the Deacons are asking you to please contribute money towards the Socks & Undies Drive. You can do this in a variety of ways; most from the comfort of your home. The money will be given to the Gospel Rescue Mission Thrift Shop, which has a new location at 1760 West Hadley across from Max's Meats. If you choose to donate items or money there directly, they are open Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 10-12. Wyleen Saunders heads up the distribution of children's clothing from this location. Her number is 642-9619, if you'd like to make a direct donation at the shop.

You are also welcome to contribute by writing a check to First Presbyterian Church in any amount you prefer. Simply write Socks & Undies on the memo line in the left corner and your donation will be directed to the fundraiser.
