Isaiah 45:18-23, 25 Philippians 2:1-13

Isaiah 45:18-23, 25 (New Revised Standard Version)

For thus says the Lord, who created the heavens (he is God!), who formed the earth and made it (he established it; he did not create it a chaos, he formed it to be inhabited!): I am the Lord, and there is no other. I did not speak in secret, in a land of darkness; I did not say to the offspring of Jacob, "Seek me in chaos." I the Lord speak the truth, I declare what is right. Assemble yourselves and come together, draw near, you survivors of the nations! They have no knowledge— those who carry about their wooden idols, and keep on praying to a god that cannot save. Declare and present your case; let them take counsel together! Who told this long ago? Who declared it of old? Was it not I, the Lord? There is no other god besides me, a righteous God and a Savior; there is no one besides me. Turn to me and be saved, all the ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other. By myself I have sworn, from my mouth has gone forth in righteousness a word that shall not return: "To me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear." In the Lord all the offspring of Israel shall triumph and glory.

Philippians 2:1-13 (New Revised Standard Version)

If then there is any encouragement in Christ, any consolation from love, any sharing in the Spirit, any compassion and sympathy, make my joy complete: be of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind. Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility regard others as better than yourselves. Let each of you look not to your own interests, but to the interests of others. Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God as something to be exploited, but emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, being born in human likeness. And being found in human form, he humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death—even death on a cross. Therefore God also highly exalted him and gave him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Therefore, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed me, not only in my presence, but much more now in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who is at work in you, enabling you both to will and to work for his good pleasure.

Leader: This is the word of the Lord.

People: **Thanks be to God.**

Isaías 45:18-23, 25 (Nueva Versión Internacional)

Fuera de mí no hay otro Dios; Dios justo y Salvador, no hay ningún otro fuera de mí. ²² »Vuelvan a mí y sean salvos, todos los confines de la tierra, porque yo soy Dios, y no hay ningún otro. ²³ He jurado por mí mismo, con integridad he pronunciado una palabra irrevocable: Ante mí se doblará toda rodilla, y por mí jurará toda lengua. ²⁵ Pero toda la descendencia de Israel será vindicada y exaltada en el SEÑOR.

Filipenses 2:1-13 (Nueva Versión Internacional)

2 Por tanto, si sienten algún estímulo en su unión con Cristo, algún consuelo en su amor, algún compañerismo en el Espíritu, algún afecto entrañable, ² llénenme de alegría teniendo un mismo parecer, un mismo amor, unidos en alma y pensamiento. ³ No hagan nada por egoísmo o vanidad; más bien, con humildad consideren a los demás como superiores a ustedes mismos. ⁴ Cada uno debe velar no solo por sus propios intereses, sino también por los intereses de los demás. ⁵ La actitud de ustedes debe ser como la de Cristo Jesús, ⁶ quien, siendo por naturaleza Dios, no consideró el ser igual a Dios como algo a qué aferrarse. ⁷ Por el contrario, se rebajó voluntariamente, tomando la naturaleza de siervo y haciéndose semejante a los seres humanos. ⁸ Y, al manifestarse como hombre, se humilló a sí mismo y se hizo obediente hasta la muerte, ¡y muerte de cruz! ⁹ Por eso Dios lo exaltó hasta lo sumo y le otorgó el nombre que está sobre todo nombre, ¹⁰ para que ante el nombre de Jesús se doble toda rodilla en el cielo y en la tierra y debajo de la tierra, ¹¹ y toda lengua confiese que Jesucristo es el Señor, para gloria de Dios Padre. ¹² Así que, mis queridos hermanos, como han obedecido siempre —no solo en mi presencia, sino mucho más ahora en mi ausencia— lleven a cabo su salvación con temor y temblor, ¹³ pues Dios es quien produce en ustedes tanto el querer como el hacer para que se cumpla su buena voluntad.
