Genesis 1:1-5 Mark 1:4-11

Genesis 1:1-5 (New Revised Standard Version)

In the beginning when God created the heavens and the earth, the earth was a formless void and darkness covered the face of the deep, while a wind from God swept over the face of the waters. Then God said, ‘Let there be light’; and there was light. And God saw that the light was good; and God separated the light from the darkness. God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And there was evening and there was morning, the first day.

Mark 1:4-11 (New Revised Standard Version)

John the baptizer appeared in the wilderness, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. And people from the whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem were going out to him, and were baptized by him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins. Now John was clothed with camel’s hair, with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. He proclaimed, ‘The one who is more powerful than I is coming after me; I am not worthy to stoop down and untie the thong of his sandals. I have baptized you with water; but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.’ In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. And just as he was coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens torn apart and the Spirit descending like a dove on him. And a voice came from heaven, ‘You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased.’

Leader: This is the word of the Lord.

People: **Thanks be to God.**

Génesis 1:1-5 (Nueva Versión Internacional)

Dios, en el principio, creó los cielos y la tierra.² La tierra era un caos total, las tinieblas cubrían el abismo, y el Espíritu de Dios se movía sobre la superficie de las aguas.³ Y dijo Dios: ¡Que exista la luz! Y la luz llegó a existir.⁴ Dios consideró que la luz era buena y la separó de las tinieblas.⁵ A la luz la llamó día, y a las tinieblas, noche. Y vino la noche, y llegó la mañana: ese fue el primer día.

Marcos 1:4-11 (Nueva Versión Internacional)

⁴ Así se presentó Juan, bautizando en el desierto y predicando el bautismo de arrepentimiento para el perdón de pecados.⁵ Toda la gente de la región de Judea y de la ciudad de Jerusalén acudía a él. Cuando confesaban sus pecados, él los bautizaba en el río Jordán.⁶ La ropa de Juan estaba hecha de pelo de camello. Llevaba puesto un cinturón de cuero, y comía langostas y miel silvestre.⁷ Predicaba de esta manera: «Después de mí viene uno más poderoso que yo; ni siquiera merezco agacharme para desatar la correa de sus sandalias.⁸ Yo los he bautizado a ustedes con agua, pero él los bautizará con el Espíritu Santo».⁹ En esos días llegó Jesús desde Nazaret de Galilea y fue bautizado por Juan en el Jordán.¹⁰ En seguida, al subir del agua, Jesús vio que el cielo se abría y que el Espíritu bajaba sobre él como una paloma.¹¹ También se oyó una voz del cielo que decía: «Tú eres mi Hijo amado; estoy muy complacido contigo.
