Joshua 24:1, 14-21 (New Revised Standard Version)

Then Joshua gathered all the tribes of Israel to Shechem, and summoned the elders, the heads, the judges, and the officers of Israel; and they presented themselves before God. “Now therefore revere the Lord, and serve him in sincerity and in faithfulness; put away the gods that your ancestors served beyond the River and in Egypt, and serve the Lord. Now if you are unwilling to serve the Lord, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served in the region beyond the River or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you are living; but as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.” Then the people answered, “Far be it from us that we should forsake the Lord to serve other gods; for it is the Lord our God who brought us and our ancestors up from the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery, and who did those great signs in our sight. He protected us along all the way that we went, and among all the peoples through whom we passed; and the Lord drove out before us all the peoples, the Amorites who lived in the land. Therefore we also will serve the Lord, for he is our God.” But Joshua said to the people, “You cannot serve the Lord, for he is

a holy God. He is a jealous God; he will not forgive your transgressions or your sins. If you forsake the Lord and serve foreign gods, then he will turn and do you harm, and consume you, after having done you good.” And the people said to Joshua, “No, we will serve the Lord!”

Mark 8:27-37 (New Revised Standard Version)

Jesus went on with his disciples to the villages of Caesarea Philippi; and on the way he asked his disciples, “Who do people say that I am?” And they answered him, “John the Baptist; and others, Elijah; and still others, one of the prophets.” He asked them, “But who do you say that I am?” Peter answered him, “You are the Messiah.” And he sternly ordered them not to tell anyone about him. Then he began to teach them that the Son of Man must undergo great suffering, and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again. He said all this quite openly. And Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. But turning and looking at his disciples, he rebuked Peter and said, “Get behind me, Satan! For you are setting your mind not on divine things but on human things.” He called the crowd with his disciples, and said to them, “If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. For those who want to save their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake, and for the sake of the gospel, will save it. For what will it profit them to gain the whole world and forfeit their life? Indeed, what can they give in return for their life?

Leader: This is the word of the Lord.

People: **Thanks be to God.**

Josué 24:1, 14-21 (Nueva Versión Internacional)

24 Josué reunió a todas las tribus de Israel en Siquén. Allí convocó a todos los jefes, líderes, jueces y oficiales del pueblo. Todos se reunieron en presencia de Dios.
¹⁴ »Por lo tanto, ahora ustedes entréguese al SEÑOR y sírvanle fielmente. Desháganse de los dioses que sus antepasados adoraron al otro lado del río Éufrates y en Egipto, y sirvan solo al SEÑOR.¹⁵ Pero, si a ustedes les parece mal servir al SEÑOR, elijan ustedes mismos a quiénes van a servir: a los dioses que sirvieron sus antepasados al otro lado del río Éufrates, o a los dioses de los amorreos, en cuya tierra ustedes ahora habitan. Por mi parte, mi familia y yo serviremos al SEÑOR». ¹⁶ El pueblo respondió: —¡Eso no pasará jamás! ¡Nosotros no abandonaremos al SEÑOR por servir a otros dioses! ¹⁷ El SEÑOR nuestro Dios es quien nos sacó a nosotros y a nuestros antepasados del país de Egipto, aquella tierra de servidumbre. Él fue quien hizo aquellas grandes señales ante nuestros ojos. Nos protegió durante todo nuestro peregrinaje por el desierto y cuando pasamos entre tantas naciones.¹⁸ El SEÑOR expulsó a todas las que vivían en este país, incluso a los amorreos. Por esa razón, nosotros también serviremos al SEÑOR, porque él es nuestro Dios. ¹⁹ Entonces Josué les dijo: —Ustedes son incapaces de servir al SEÑOR, porque él es Dios santo y Dios celoso. No les tolerará sus rebeliones y pecados. ²⁰ Si ustedes lo abandonan y sirven a dioses ajenos, él se les echará encima y les traerá desastre; los

destruirá completamente, a pesar de haber sido bueno con ustedes. ²¹ *Pero el pueblo insistió: —¡Eso no pasará jamás! Nosotros solo serviremos al SEÑOR.*

Marcos 8:27-37 (Nueva Versión Internacional)

²⁷ *Jesús y sus discípulos salieron hacia las aldeas de Cesarea de Filipo. En el camino les preguntó: —¿Quién dice la gente que soy yo? ²⁸—Unos dicen que Juan el Bautista, otros que Elías, y otros que uno de los profetas —contestaron. ²⁹—Y ustedes, ¿quién dicen que soy yo? —Tú eres el Cristo —afirmó Pedro. ³⁰ Jesús les ordenó que no hablaran a nadie acerca de él. ³¹ Luego comenzó a enseñarles: —El Hijo del hombre tiene que sufrir muchas cosas y ser rechazado por los ancianos, por los jefes de los sacerdotes y por los maestros de la ley. Es necesario que lo maten y que a los tres días resucite. ³² Habló de esto con toda claridad. Pedro lo llevó aparte y comenzó a reprenderlo. ³³ Pero Jesús se dio la vuelta, miró a sus discípulos, y reprendió a Pedro. —¡Aléjate de mí, Satanás! —le dijo—. Tú no piensas en las cosas de Dios, sino en las de los hombres. ³⁴ Entonces llamó a la multitud y a sus discípulos. —Si alguien quiere ser mi discípulo —les dijo—, que se niegue a sí mismo, lleve su cruz y me siga. ³⁵ Porque el que quiera salvar su vida la perderá; pero el que pierda su vida por mi causa y por el evangelio la salvará. ³⁶ ¿De qué sirve ganar el mundo entero si se pierde la vida? ³⁷ ¿O qué se puede dar a cambio de la vida?*
