We are set free to follow Jesus. Friends, believe the Good News, in Jesus Christ all our sins are forgiven.

People: **Believing and trusting the Good News, in Jesus Christ we are forgiven and set free to follow Jesus. Thanks be to God.**

Leader: What is the process of grace and faith?

People: **The grace of faith, whereby the elect are enabled to believe to the saving of their souls, is the work of the Spirit of Christ in their hearts; and is ordinarily wrought by the ministry of the Word: by which also, and by the administration of the sacraments, and prayer, it is increased and strengthened. By this faith, a Christian believeth to be true whatsoever is revealed in the Word, for the authority of God himself speaking therein.... But the principal acts of saving faith are, accepting, receiving, and resting upon Christ alone for justification, sanctification, and eternal life, by virtue of the covenant of grace.¹**

Exodus 6:2-9

Romans 8:1-2, 5-6, 9, 14-18

Exodus 6:2-9 (New Revised Standard Version)

God also spoke to Moses and said to him: “I am the Lord. I appeared to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob as God Almighty, but by my name ‘The Lord’ I did not make myself known to them. I also established my covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land in which they resided as aliens. I have also heard the groaning of the Israelites whom the Egyptians are holding as slaves, and I have remembered my covenant. Say therefore to the Israelites, ‘I am the Lord, and I will free you from the burdens of the Egyptians and deliver you from slavery to them. I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with mighty acts of judgment. I will take you as my people, and I will be your God. You shall know that I am the Lord your God, who has freed you from the burdens of the Egyptians. I will bring you into the land that I swore to give to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; I will give it to you for a possession. I am the Lord.’” Moses told this to the Israelites; but they would not listen to Moses, because of their broken spirit and their cruel slavery.

Romans 8:1-2, 5-6, 9, 14-18 (New Revised Standard Version)

There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death. For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit. To set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and

peace. But you are not in the flesh; you are in the Spirit, since the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God. For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received a spirit of adoption. When we cry, “Abba! Father!” it is that very Spirit bearing witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ—if, in fact, we suffer with him so that we may also be glorified with him. I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory about to be revealed to us.

Leader: This is the word of the Lord.

People: **Thanks be to God.**

Éxodo 6:2-9 (Nueva Versión Internacional)

² En otra ocasión, Dios habló con Moisés y le dijo: «Yo soy el SEÑOR. ³ Me aparecí a Abraham, a Isaac y a Jacob bajo el nombre de Dios Todopoderoso, pero no les revelé mi verdadero nombre, que es el SEÑOR. ⁴ También con ellos confirmé mi pacto de darles la tierra de Canaán, donde residieron como forasteros. ⁵ He oído además el gemir de los israelitas, a quienes los egipcios han esclavizado, y he recordado mi pacto. ⁶ Así que ve y diles a los israelitas: “Yo soy el SEÑOR, y voy a quitarles de encima la opresión de los egipcios. Voy a librarlos de su esclavitud; voy a liberarlos con gran despliegue de poder y con grandes actos de justicia. ⁷ Haré de ustedes mi pueblo; y yo seré su Dios. Yo, el SEÑOR, les daré a ustedes posesión de ella”. ⁹ Moisés les dio a conocer esto a los israelitas, pero por su desánimo y las penurias de su esclavitud ellos no le hicieron caso.

Romanos 8:1-2, 5-6, 9, 14-18 (Nueva Versión Internacional)

⁸ Por lo tanto, ya no hay ninguna condenación para los que están unidos a Cristo Jesús, ² pues por medio de él la ley del Espíritu de vida me ha liberado de la ley del pecado y de la muerte. ⁵ Los que viven conforme a la naturaleza pecaminosa fijan la mente en los deseos de tal naturaleza; en cambio, los que viven conforme al Espíritu fijan la mente en los deseos del Espíritu. ⁶ La mentalidad pecaminosa es muerte, mientras que la mentalidad que proviene del Espíritu es vida y paz. ⁹ Sin embargo, ustedes no viven según la naturaleza pecaminosa, sino según el Espíritu, si es que el Espíritu de Dios vive en ustedes. Y, si alguno no tiene el Espíritu de Cristo, no es de Cristo. ¹⁴ Porque todos los que son guiados por el Espíritu de Dios son hijos de Dios. ¹⁵ Y ustedes no recibieron un espíritu que de nuevo los esclavice al miedo, sino el Espíritu que los adopta como hijos y les permite clamar: «¡Abba! ¡Padre!» ¹⁶ El Espíritu mismo le asegura a nuestro espíritu que somos hijos de Dios. ¹⁷ Y, si somos hijos, somos herederos; herederos de Dios y coherederos con Cristo, pues, si ahora sufrimos con él, también tendremos parte con él en su gloria. ¹⁸ De hecho, considero que en nada se comparan los sufrimientos actuales con la gloria que habrá de revelarse en nosotros.
