1 Samuel 16:1-13 Mark 4:26-32

1 Samuel 16:1-13 (New Revised Standard Version)

The Lord said to Samuel, “How long will you grieve over Saul? I have rejected him from being king over Israel. Fill your horn with oil and set out; I will send you to Jesse the Bethlehemite, for I have provided for myself a king among his sons.”² Samuel said, “How can I go? If Saul hears of it, he will kill me.” And the Lord said, “Take a heifer with you, and say, ‘I have come to sacrifice to the Lord.’³ Invite Jesse to the sacrifice, and I will show you what you shall do; and you shall anoint for me the one whom I name to you.”⁴ Samuel did what the Lord commanded, and came to Bethlehem. The elders of the city came to meet him trembling, and said, “Do you come peaceably?”⁵ He said, “Peaceably; I have come to sacrifice to the Lord; sanctify yourselves and come with me to the sacrifice.” And he sanctified Jesse and his sons and invited them to the sacrifice.⁶ When they came, he looked on Eliab and thought, “Surely the Lord’s anointed is now before the Lord.”⁷ But the Lord said to Samuel, “Do not look on his appearance or on the height of his stature, because I have rejected him; for the Lord does not see as mortals see; they look on the outward appearance, but the Lord looks on the heart.”⁸ Then Jesse called Abinadab, and made him pass before Samuel. He said, “Neither has the Lord chosen this one.”⁹ Then Jesse made Shammah pass by. And he said, “Neither has the Lord chosen this one.”¹⁰ Jesse made seven of his sons pass before Samuel, and Samuel said to Jesse, “The Lord has not chosen any of these.”¹¹ Samuel said to Jesse, “Are all your sons here?” And he said, “There remains

yet the youngest, but he is keeping the sheep.” And Samuel said to Jesse, “Send and bring him; for we will not sit down until he comes here.” ¹²He sent and brought him in. Now he was ruddy, and had beautiful eyes, and was handsome. The Lord said, “Rise and anoint him; for this is the one.” ¹³Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the presence of his brothers; and the spirit of the Lord came mightily upon David from that day forward. Samuel then set out and went to Ramah.

Mark 4:26-32 (New Revised Standard Version)

²⁶He also said, “The kingdom of God is as if someone would scatter seed on the ground, ²⁷and would sleep and rise night and day, and the seed would sprout and grow, he does not know how. ²⁸The earth produces of itself, first the stalk, then the head, then the full grain in the head. ²⁹But when the grain is ripe, at once he goes in with his sickle, because the harvest has come.” ³⁰He also said, “With what can we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable will we use for it? ³¹It is like a mustard seed, which, when sown upon the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on earth; ³²yet when it is sown it grows up and becomes the greatest of all shrubs, and puts forth large branches, so that the birds of the air can make nests in its shade.”

1 Samuel 16:1-13 Nueva Versión Internacional

El SEÑOR le dijo a Samuel: —¿Cuánto tiempo vas a quedarte llorando por Saúl, si ya lo he rechazado como rey de Israel? Mejor llena de aceite tu cuerno, y ponte en camino. Voy a enviarte a Belén, a la casa de Isaí, pues he escogido como rey a uno de sus hijos. ²—¿Y cómo voy a ir? —respondió Samuel—. Si Saúl llega a enterarse, me matará. —Lleva una ternera —dijo el SEÑOR—, y diles que vas a ofrecerle al SEÑOR un sacrificio. ³Invita a Isaí al sacrificio, y entonces te explicaré lo que debes hacer, pues ungirás para mi servicio a quien yo te diga. ⁴Samuel hizo lo que le mandó el SEÑOR. Pero, cuando llegó a Belén, los ancianos del pueblo lo recibieron con mucho temor. —¿Vienes en son de paz? —le preguntaron. ⁵—Claro que sí. He venido a ofrecerle al SEÑOR un sacrificio. Purifíquense y vengan conmigo para tomar parte en él. Entonces Samuel purificó a Isaí y a sus hijos, y los invitó al sacrificio. ⁶Cuando llegaron, Samuel se fijó en Eliab y pensó: «Sin duda que este es el ungido del SEÑOR». ⁷Pero el SEÑOR le dijo a Samuel: —No te dejes impresionar por su apariencia ni por su estatura, pues yo lo he rechazado. La gente se fija en las apariencias, pero yo me fijo en el corazón. ⁸Entonces Isaí llamó a Abinadab para presentárselo a Samuel, pero Samuel dijo: —A este no lo ha escogido el SEÑOR. ⁹Luego le presentó a Sama, y Samuel repitió: —Tampoco a este lo ha escogido. ¹⁰Isaí le presentó a siete de sus hijos, pero Samuel le dijo: —El SEÑOR no ha escogido a ninguno de ellos. ¹¹—¿Son estos todos tus hijos? —Queda el más pequeño —respondió Isaí—, pero está cuidando el rebaño. —Manda a buscarlo —insistió Samuel—, que no podemos continuar hasta que él llegue. ¹²Isaí mandó a buscarlo, y se lo trajeron. Era buen mozo, trigueño y de buena

presencia. El SEÑOR le dijo a Samuel: —Este es; levántate y úngelo. ¹³ Samuel tomó el cuerno de aceite y ungíó al joven en presencia de sus hermanos. Entonces el Espíritu del SEÑOR vino con poder sobre David, y desde ese día estuvo con él. Luego Samuel regresó a Ramá.

Marcos 4:26-32 Nueva Versión Internacional

²⁶ Jesús continuó: «El reino de Dios se parece a quien esparce semilla en la tierra. ²⁷ Sin que este sepa cómo, y ya sea que duerma o esté despierto, día y noche brota y crece la semilla. ²⁸ La tierra da fruto por sí sola; primero el tallo, luego la espiga, y después el grano lleno en la espiga. ²⁹ Tan pronto como el grano está maduro, se le mete la hoz, pues ha llegado el tiempo de la cosecha». ³⁰ También dijo: «¿Con qué vamos a comparar el reino de Dios? ¿Qué parábola podemos usar para describirlo? ³¹ Es como un grano de mostaza: cuando se siembra en la tierra, es la semilla más pequeña que hay, ³² pero una vez sembrada crece hasta convertirse en la más grande de las hortalizas, y echa ramas tan grandes que las aves pueden anidar bajo su sombra».
