The word 'Maundy' comes from the Latin word for commandment, *mandatum*. This is a special day for Christians. It is the day when we remember the Last Supper, the agony in the garden of Gethsemane, and the arrest and trial of Jesus. The Last Supper is a key event and Sacrament for Christian believers. It was at this Last Supper which Jesus shared with his friends that he changed the words of the traditional Passover meal and commanded his followers to break and eat bread and drink wine in his memory. This act of remembrance is known as the Eucharist, Holy Communion, Mass, or The Lord's Supper.
